2. Product Description

Joe Mama's Cutting Board Oil is a food-safe liquid conditioning oil formulated for the regular maintenance and protection of wooden cutting boards, butcher blocks, salad bowls and charcuterie boards. The food-grade white mineral oil penetrates the timber to replace lost moisture, helping to prevent drying, staining and cracking, and leaving a food-safe, water-resistant finish.

Joe Mama's is a brand of ToolShark Holdings. Blended in small batches in Cape Town, South Africa.

5. Application Instructions

- Ensure the wooden surface is clean and dry.
- Apply generously with a clean lint-free cloth, flooding the surface.
- Allow to soak in, ideally overnight, until absorbed.
- Wipe off any excess with a clean dry cloth.
- Re-apply weekly for the first month on new boards, then monthly or as needed.

6. Safety & Regulatory Information

All components are food-grade and listed for use in food-contact applications. Food-grade white mineral oil complies with FDA 21 CFR 178.3620(a) and beeswax with FDA 21 CFR 184.1973. The finished product is non-toxic and suitable for surfaces that contact food once the excess has been buffed off.

7. Storage & Shelf Life

Store in a cool, dry place out of direct sunlight. Replace lid after use. Typical shelf life is 24 months from date of manufacture when stored as directed.
