2. Product Description

Joe Mama's White Beeswax is refined, filtered beeswax supplied in easy-melting pellet form. The refining process gives it a neutral pale colour and minimal scent, making it ideal for finishes on pale woods and for light-coloured candles and cosmetics. Same natural beeswax as our yellow grade, simply filtered and clarified. Food-safe and naturally derived.

Joe Mama's is a brand of ToolShark Holdings. Packed in small batches in Cape Town, South Africa.

5. Application Instructions

- Gently melt the required amount in a double boiler or heat-safe container over low heat.
- Blend with food-grade oils to make your own wood-care pastes, balms or polishes; or use neat for candles and cosmetics.
- Stir until fully combined, then pour or decant and allow to set.

- For wood care, apply the finished blend to clean, dry timber with a lint-free cloth and buff to a soft sheen.
- Adjust the wax-to-oil ratio to make the blend firmer or softer to taste.

6. Safety & Regulatory Information

Beeswax is a natural, food-safe wax widely used in food-contact, confectionery and cosmetic applications. It complies with food-contact use under FDA 21 CFR 184.1973 and is permitted as food additive E901. The finished product is non-toxic and suitable for surfaces that contact food once any excess has been buffed off.

7. Storage & Shelf Life

Store in a cool, dry place out of direct sunlight. Reseal the pouch after use. Beeswax is very stable; typical shelf life is 36 months or more from date of manufacture when stored as directed.
